A Note From John Cook (an excerpt from a recent letter)

Hi Jerry, Kathy, Kenny, Jonathan and everyone at One-Way.

I have been really convicted to pray more the past few days, and mustered the best of my feeble ability to do so. This morning, I also was in prayer from 5:30 till 8 AM. Before our Adult Sunday School at 9 AM, one of our young adult ladies, Kelly said that she and Felisha want to be Baptized. (Both girls attend regularly. Felisha is married to a Hindu-the person I rent my house from). I arranged for them to meet with me tomorrow afternoon at 5:30 PM.

Our service this morning was packed. I preached from Joshua 8:30-35: why it is important for Christians to glorify Jesus together as a congregation (because of his holiness, provision, and promises). And, I had announced to the congregation that there were some who were interested in being Baptized. Afterward, another lady, Mala approached me and said she wanted to be Baptized. (She isn't a member either, but has been attending regularly). I arranged for her to meet me along with the other two. What an encouragement in response to intense prayer!

Please be in prayer for me for wisdom, and humility for them, as I meet with these ladies to instruct and determine whether or not they are indeed saved, and whether or not they are ready and willing to take a stand for Christ- "to contend earnestly for the faith".
